Study Visa (Uniform Schengen Visa C / National Visa D)

Required Documents:

1. Schengen Visa application form fully completed, signed, and dated.
2. 1 recent passport-size photograph with a clear background and dimensions of 35*40 mm (the size approved by the International Civil Aviation Organization - ICAO).
3. A passport valid for at least 3 months after the expiration date of the requested visa. A copy of the same passport and previous passports if any (pages containing personal data and all pages containing stamps and visas).
4. Travel medical insurance with a coverage of no less than 30,000 Euros, valid for the entire duration of the trip and period of stay in the European Union countries, to cover any medical or emergency expenses, hospital treatment costs, or repatriation of the body due to illness or death.
5. Financial resources proportional to the duration of the requested stay, as stipulated by the current directives of the Italian Ministry of Interior and the annual circular of the Ministry of Education and Merit. An original bank statement for the last 6 months, dated and signed by the bank, must be submitted.
6. A round-trip flight ticket booking for the Uniform Schengen Visa or a one-way flight ticket for the National Visa. In case of traveling by land using personal means of transportation or movements within European countries, the visa applicant must submit a letter explaining the itinerary and the means of transportation used (domestic railways or buses in European countries).
7. Confirmed accommodation booking or an invitation letter from a person residing in Italy accompanied by a copy of their identity document. If the inviter is not a European citizen, a copy of their residence permit (Permesso di Soggiorno) and a copy of their passport must be sent.
8. Course enrollment letter issued by the institution where the study will take place.

For a Study Visa / University Enrollment, the following must also be submitted:

9. Pre-enrollment letter for the course issued from the University portal.
10. Language proficiency certificate for the language of the course, minimum level B2.
11. Documents proving previous studies.

For a Study Visa / Post-Graduate, the following must also be submitted:

12. Pre-enrollment letter for the postgraduate course issued from the University portal or an acceptance letter from the specific faculty.
13. Language proficiency certificate for the language of the course, minimum level B2.
14. Documents proving previous studies.

For a Study Visa / Exchange and Mobility Program, the following must also be submitted:

15. A valid exchange agreement between the university and the Italian or foreign institution, or a letter of participation in programs recognized or authorized at the European level.
16. A detailed learning agreement signed by the host university/institution, the home university/institution, and the applicant.

17. Documents proving previous studies or enrollment in a study program at the home university/institution.
18. Language proficiency certificate for the language of the course, minimum level B2.

For a Study Visa / Training or Extracurricular Internship, the following must also be submitted:

19. A practical internship project approved by the competent administration in the region where the training will take place.
20. Registration of the internship on the Ministry of Labor platform 'Cliclavoro'.
21. Documents proving previous studies or training.

For a Study Visa / Italian Language Courses, the following must also be submitted:

22. A letter explaining the level, duration, and program of the language course.
23. Documents proving previous training/formation in the language through the country of origin.

Obtaining an entry visa for study and training in the healthcare field is subject to prior recognition of qualifications by the Italian Ministry of Health. In the event that there is no intention to practice activities related to healthcare, the visa application must include an explicit declaration to this effect by the legal representative of the facility where the study will be conducted.

Attention:

- When submitting photocopies of documents, the originals must be presented for review at the time of application submission.
- Documents must be submitted either already issued in both languages or translated into the Italian language.
- The list of documents mentioned above serves as a guideline for the public only; the office reserves the right to conduct further inquiries as appropriate and to request additional documents.
