Diplomatic Visa (National Visa D)

A diplomatic visa for accreditation or notification allows entry into Italy for a long-term, indefinite stay for a foreign citizen who holds a diplomatic or service passport and is scheduled to work at their country's diplomatic/consular missions in Italy or the Holy See.

Diplomatic visas may also be issued to family members of the visa holder.

Required Documents:

1. Schengen Visa application form fully completed, signed, and dated.
2. 1 recent passport-size photograph with a clear background and dimensions of 35*40 mm (the size approved by the International Civil Aviation Organization - ICAO).
3. A passport valid for at least 3 months after the expiration date of the requested visa. A copy of the same passport and previous passports if any (pages containing personal data and all pages containing stamps and visas).
4. A round-trip flight booking. In case of traveling by land using personal means of transportation or movements within European countries, the visa applicant must submit a letter explaining the itinerary and the means of transportation used (domestic railways or buses in European countries).
5. Documents proving the employee's status.
6. A Note Verbale from the Egyptian Ministry of Foreign Affairs or from an accredited diplomatic mission in the country requesting the visa, clarifying the following:
Personal data of the visa applicant.
The job position they will occupy.
The employment start date.
Personal data of the family members of the visa applicant.

The issuance of the visa is always subject to the approval of the Diplomatic Protocol Department of the Italian Republic.

Attention:

When submitting photocopies of documents, the originals must be presented for review at the time of application submission.

Documents must be submitted either already issued in both languages or translated into the Italian language.

The list of documents mentioned above serves as a guideline for the public only; the office reserves the right to conduct further inquiries as appropriate and to request additional documents.
