Family Reunification Visa (National Visa D)

The visa allows entry for long-term stay through an invitation from a legally residing family member for the following categories:

- The spouse (or civil union partner) not legally separated and not less than 18 years of age.
- Minor children, including children of the spouse or children born out of wedlock, with the prior consent of the other parent, if any. Minor children are those under 18 years of age at the time of submitting the application for approval to the Single Desk for Immigration (Sportello Unico per l'Immigrazione).
- Dependent adult children, if they are unable to provide for their essential living needs due to a health condition resulting in total disability.
- Dependent parents, if they do not have other children in the country of residence or country of origin.
- Parents over 65 years of age, if their other children in the country of origin or country of residence are unable to support them due to serious, documented health reasons.

Required Documents:

- ☐ 1. Visa application form fully completed, signed, and dated.
- ☐ 2. 1 recent passport-size photograph with a clear background and dimensions of 35*40 mm (the size approved by the International Civil Aviation Organization - ICAO).
- ☐ 3. A passport valid for at least 3 months after the expiration date of the requested visa. A copy of the same passport and previous passports if any (pages containing personal data and all pages containing stamps and visas).
- ☐ 4. A one-way flight ticket booking.
- ☐ 5. A copy of the entry clearance (Nulla Osta) issued by the competent Single Desk for Immigration (Sportello Unico per l'Immigrazione).
- ☐ 6. Documents proving the family relationship with the applicant, provided that their issuance date does not exceed 6 months.
- ☐ 7. A copy of the applicant's residence permit (Permesso di Soggiorno).
- ☐ 8. If necessary, documents proving dependency/financial support.

Attention:

- When submitting photocopies of documents, the originals must be presented for review at the time of application submission.

- Documents must be submitted either already issued in both languages or translated into the Italian language.
- The list of documents mentioned above serves as a guideline for the public only; the office reserves the right to conduct further inquiries as appropriate and to request additional documents.
